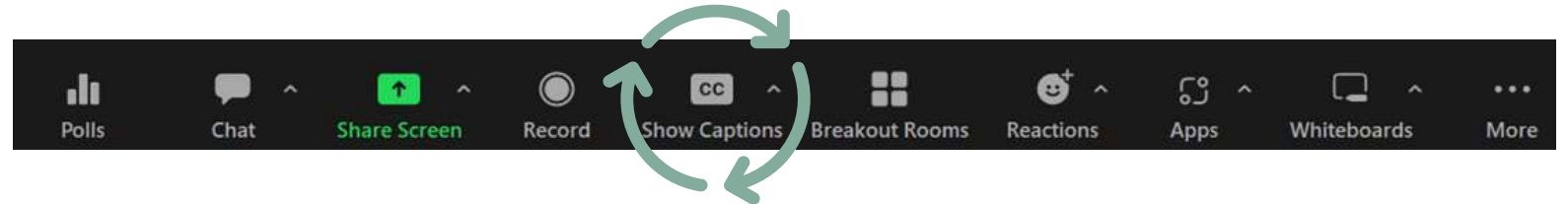

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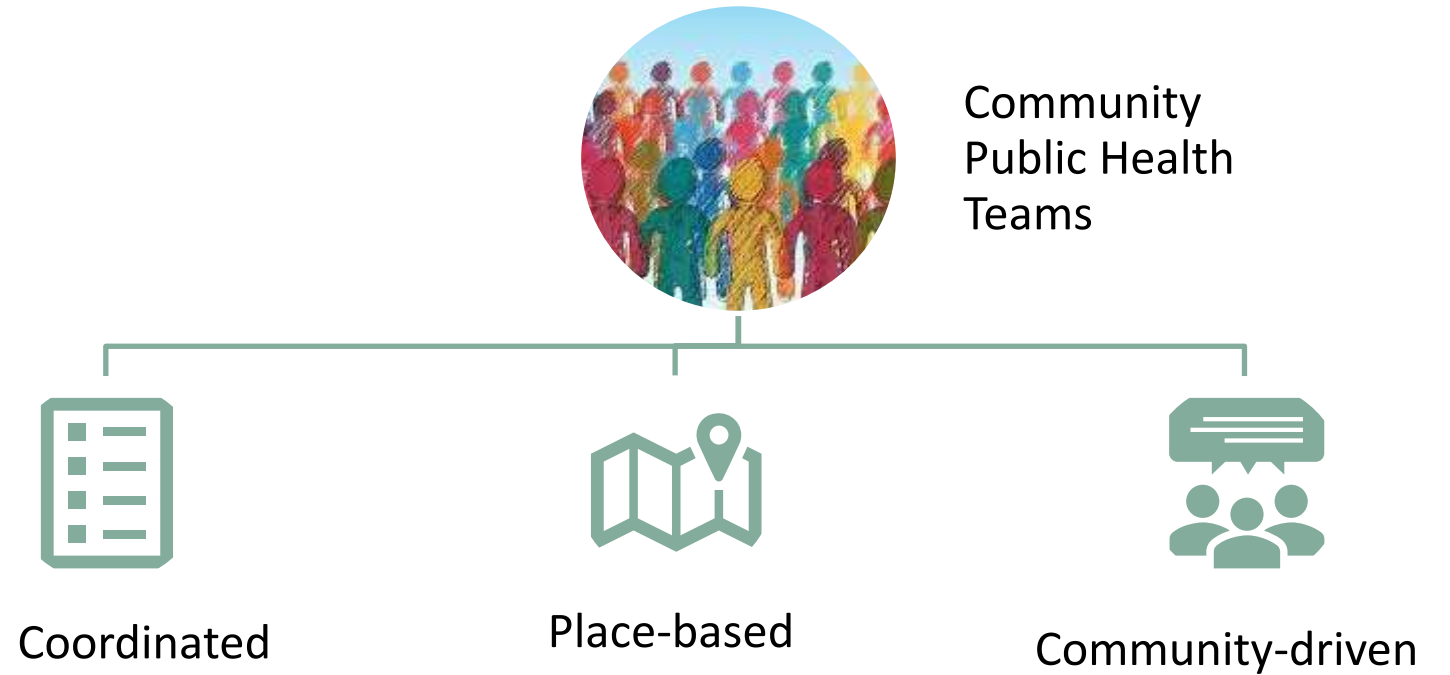

**GOAL: Build a community-centered system of care and strengthen the infrastructure needed to deliver coordinated, community-based services to individuals and highly impacted communities**

# CPHT Key Elements

## Workforce Expansion

- Expand the public health workforce through partnerships with community-based organizations and local health care partners.



## Capacity Building

- Build and maintain capacity of CPHTs to develop and apply equitable policies and practices to improve health outcomes of disproportionately impacted populations.



## Service Coordination

- Expand the coordination and provision of field-based public health services to improve individual and community level health outcomes.



## Strengthening Partnerships

- Mobilize partners to advance health equity and address social determinants of health.



## Resource Networking

- Utilize a community-driven approach to build regional resource networks that address the needs of priority communities.



# CPHT Partnerships

## CPHT PARTNERSHIPS

The core members of each CPHT will represent diverse disciplines comprised of staff from local CBOs, community health care partners, and DPH to engage residents and address community health priorities. CPHTs will identify and secure additional partners to provide requested community resources and services aligned with community-identified need.

### 10 Target Communities

- Outreach and education
- System navigation
- Data collection
- Communications
- Community Action Plans
- Community convener
- Health care services
- Disease Investigation
- Health linkages

# Core Strategies



Visit each household to conduct household needs assessment



Ensure residents are **connected** to needed health care and social services



Collect and analyze data from residents and secondary sources



**Convene** regular community meetings



Mobilize **partnerships**

# CPHT communities

## Community Selection

- Ensure geographic representation
- Utilize existing indices
  - California Healthy Places Index (HPI)
  - Social Vulnerability Index (SVI)
- Proposers to identify CPHT communities
- Meet requirement of at least 75% of census tracts in CPHT community
  - Lowest quartile for HPI OR
  - Highest quartile for SVI

Include contiguous census tracts that can be aggregated to reach 8,000 – 13,000 households

# Funding Overview

## Funding Details

- Federal: Strengthening U.S. Public Health Infrastructure, Workforce, and Data Systems Grant
- State: Future of Public Health Funding Award

## Funding Terms

- Term 1 (2 months): \$250,000
- Term 2 (12 months): \$1,500,000
- Term 3 (12 months): \$1,500,000

# Eligibility Requirements

- Consist of a partnership between a CBO and health care partner/FQHC
- Identify primary and secondary organization
- Select 5-8 high need contiguous census tracts
  - 75% of census tracts need to meet the 25% threshold
- Demonstrate at least 3 years of experience within the last 5 years
  - Community outreach and engagement
  - Working in multi-disciplinary collaborative partnerships
  - Delivering health care services
